Class VI-X

- **Co-Scholastic Area:** Achievements in Co-Scholastic Area like Work Education, Art Education, Health & Physical Education/Sports will be graded on a 5 - Point Scale (A, B, C, D, & E) for classes IX-X and 3- Point Scale (A, B & C) for Classes VI-VIII.
- **Discipline: (VI-X)** Attendance, Sincerity, Behavior, Values, Classroom Performance, Conduct, Interaction, Regularity will also be graded on a 5- Point Scale (A, B, C, D & E) for classes IX- X and 3-Point Scale (A, B & C) for Classes VI-VIII.

Class XI & XII

Achievements in Co-Scholastic Area like SUPW (Music / Dance / Art & Craft), Sports/Physical Education and General Studies will be graded on a 9-Point Scale (A1, A2, B1, B2, C1, C2, D1, D2, E)

FOR ALL THE STUDENTS

1. Final Result will be based on the overall performance i.e. Scholastic & Co-Scholastic Areas except Class XII.
2. A Minimum of 33% in each individual subject is required for promotion in all classes.
3. In Co-Scholastic Area Grade E reflects the need of improvement and unsatisfactory performance.
4. It is Mandatory to appear in Annual Exam for Promotion in all classes.
5. Supplementary exam fee Rs100 will be charged for each subject.
6. **If a student is absent in the Periodical Exam or Half Yearly Exam, without any information or valid reason neither re-test will be taken nor any marks/ grades will be given for the same.**
7. If a student fails consecutively for 2 years in the same class his/her name will be struck off from the rolls.
8. If parents want to apply for Retotalling of marks, they can do so by depositing Rs100 per subject along with the application mentioning Roll No., Name, Class and Subject of which retotalling is to done. Application should be submitted within a week after the declaration of Annual Result along with the fee.
9. Parents are requested to motivate their children to improve in the weak subjects on basis of the progress report.
